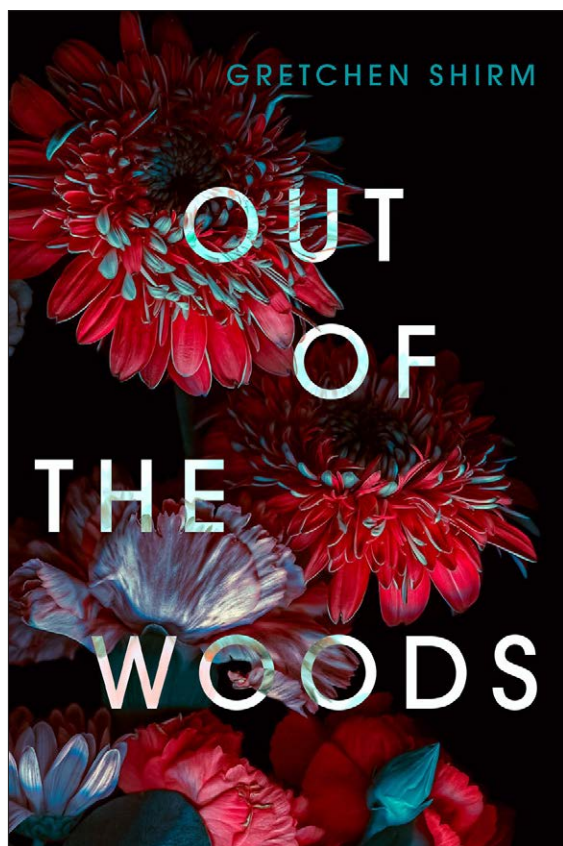

OUT OF THE WOODS

In the year 2000, an Australian woman travels to The Hague to work as the secretary for an Australian judge. There, she sits through the trial of a former military man who has been charged with war crimes. As the trial proceeds, she is confronted with two conflicting impulses: being deeply affected by the testimony of witnesses, while at the same time plagued by an enduring doubt as to the defendant's guilt.

Meanwhile, she begins an unexpected romance and friendship, and these relationships help her to understand the stories of extraordinary survival she hears about during the trial. When she is called back to Australia to reckon with her own childhood, she finds she can't quite leave everything she's heard behind. *Out of the Woods* asks what it means to bear witness to the suffering of people who have experienced real tragedy and whether it is possible, afterwards, to resume a normal life.

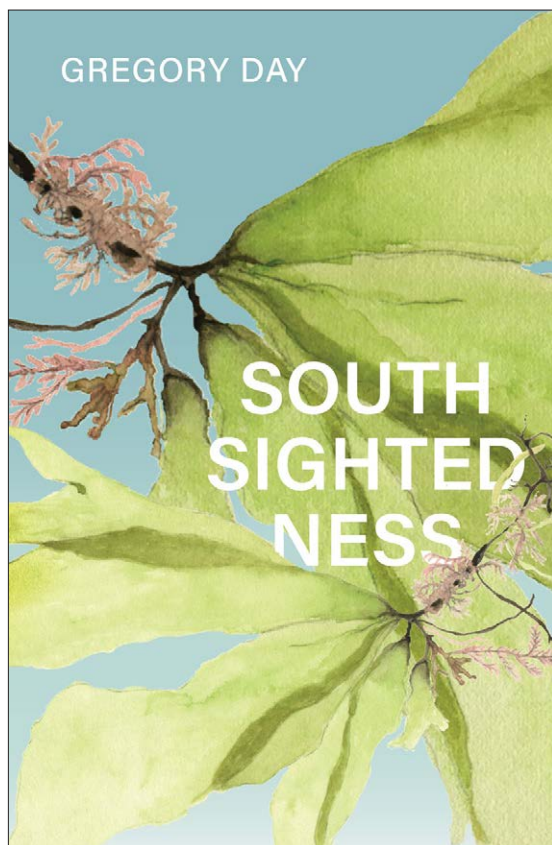

In the first book of this touching and darkly comic duology, a paladin, a forger, an assassin and a scholar ride out of town on an espionage mission with deadly serious stakes.

When forger Slate is convicted of treason, she faces a death sentence. But her unique gift for sniffing out magic (literally) earns her a reprieve – of sorts.

Along with a paladin, Caliban, possessed by a demon, her murderous ex-lover, and an irritating misogynist scholar, Slate sets off on a mission to learn about the Clockwork Boys, deadly mechanical soldiers from a neighbouring kingdom who have been terrorising their lands. If they succeed, rewards and pardons await, but they must survive a long journey through enemy territory to reach Anuket City. And Slate has her own reasons to dread returning to her former home.

Slate and her crew aren't the first to be sent on this mission. None of their predecessors have returned, and Slate can't help but feel they've exchanged one death sentence for another. Her increasing closeness to Caliban isn't helping matters: for the first time in a long time, Slate might actually care about surviving.

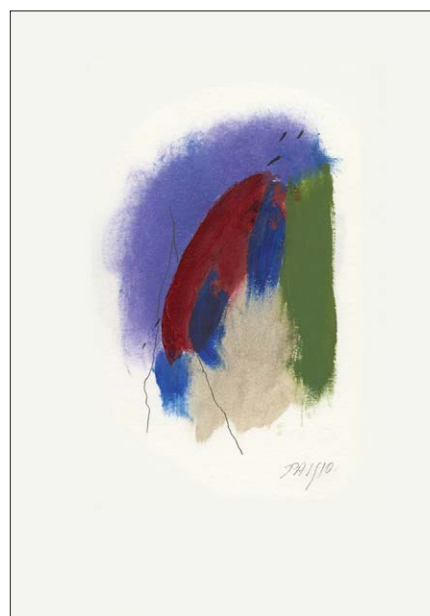

The 2022 recipient of the Patrick White Literary Award, the late Antigone Kefala was one of the first writers to open Australian fiction to a diversity of voices. She is known for her nuanced and evocative prose style, which portrays the full gamut of the immigrant experience, the fleeing from war, the resettlement in foreign countries, the difficult negotiation of personal relationships, the hauntings of memory and dream. This collection brings together Kefala's three early novellas *The First Journey*, *The Boarding House* and *The Island*, which have long been out of print, and her three later novellas, published together as *Summer Visit* by Giramondo in 2022. It also includes her childhood fable *Alexia: A Tale of Two Cultures* and ten short stories, previously only published in literary magazines, dating back to the beginnings of her career at the end of the 1950s.

In addition to her works of fiction, **Antigone Kefala** published five poetry collections, *The Alien*, *Thirsty Weather*, *European Notebook*, *Absence: New and Selected Poems* and *Fragments*, which won the 2017 Judith Wright Calanthe Award and was shortlisted for the Prime Minister's Award for Poetry. She is also renowned as a writer of journals – these were published by Giramondo in two collections, *Sydney Journals* (2008), and her last book, *Late Journals* (2022). In November 2022 she received the Patrick White Literary Award, in recognition of her contribution to Australian literature. She died in December 2022, at the age of 91.

Poetry brings together all the published poems of the late Antigone Kefala, one of the most distinctive voices in contemporary Australian literature. Her mixed background – in Romania, Greece, New Zealand and Australia – gave her lyric poetry a unique richness and grace. Her writing was informed by literary traditions that allowed her to achieve powerful effects by apparently simple means. Her poems are carefully worked, minimal yet resonant, evocative in their use of implication and understatement, startling in their imagery. They confront loss and grief and displacement, particularly as the consequences of war and migration. They excoriate pretension. They also express delight in the present moment, in newly discovered forms of experience and nature.

Poetry includes all the poems in Kefala's six previous poetry books, published over fifty years, from *The Alien* (1973) and *Thirsty Weather* (1978), to *European Notebook* (1988), *Absence: New and Selected Poems* (1992, 1998), *Fragments* (Giramondo, 2016) and *Journeys* (2019).

Fragments won the prestigious Judith Wright Calanthe Award and was shortlisted for the Prime Minister's Award for Poetry. But most of her poetry has been out of print for many years.

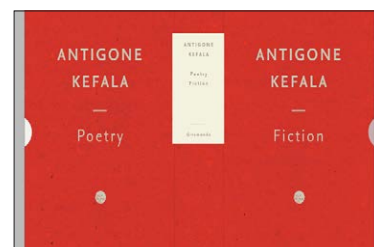

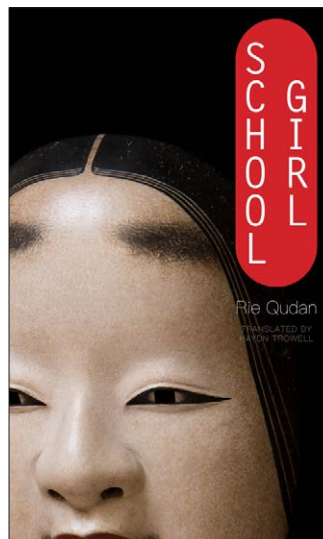
KANGAROO UNBOUND

Kangaroo Unbound is a collection of 50 poems that take their titles and inspiration from legendary Australian artist Garry's Shead's iconic 'D. H. Lawrence' series of paintings, which he produced in the early 90s in response to Lawrence's 1923 novel *Kangaroo*.

Like the paintings, the poems range from the heavily influenced (those that lean into the source text with strong ekphrastic fidelity) to those that offer more abstracted and personal renderings. Traversing a range of forms from free verse to concrete, villanelle and sonnet, the poems draw from a host of readily identifiable national motifs in their effort toward a contemporary Australian mythology grounded in 'Benevolence, Humour and Divine Mystery'.
