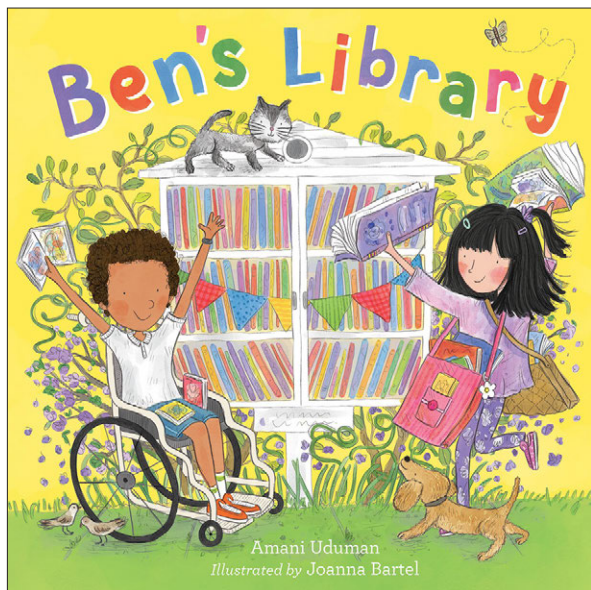
**About the author:**
