



Mary Gilmore was a trailblazing feminist journalist and labour movement organiser; Katharine Susannah Prichard wrote about the emotional conflicts inherent in European and Indigenous relationships and was a co-founder and lifelong member of the Communist Party; Eleanor Dark explored Australian colonisation and the First Nations peoples it displaced; Dymphna Cusack advocated for social reform and had strong links to labour politics; Ruth Park's *The Harp in the South* inspired the NSW government's slum clearance programs; Dorothy Hewett's novel *Bobbin Up* was one of the few western works translated into Russian during the Soviet era, and prominent First Nations poet, activist and educator Oodgeroo Noonuccal campaigned for Indigenous rights, including successful constitutional reform.



What does the daughter of a Nakba survivor inherit? It is not property or tangible heirlooms, none of which can crisscross the globe with their refugee owners. It is not the streets and neighbourhoods of a father’s childhood and the deep roots of family who have lived in one place, Jerusalem, for generation upon generation.

Fixing her gaze on moments, places and objects – from the streets of Bethlehem to the Palestinian neighbourhoods of the New Jerusalem – Micaela Sahhar assembles a story of Palestinian diaspora, returning to the origins of violence in the Nakba. *Find me at the Jaffa Gate* is a book about the gaps and blank spaces that cannot be easily recounted, but which insists on the vibrant reality of chance, fragments and memory to reclaim a place called home.







Would you ask me how to pronounce it, and later where it originated from?


What if, when I spoke, you heard my thick Australian accent? Would you wonder how I got here?

What if you saw the colour of my skin – would you ask me where I am from?

Sarah is a brown female doctor who emigrated to Australia in the 1990s. Her journey to becoming a paediatrician has been challenging, right from the schoolyard. As a minority, she was perceived as different. She tried hard to blend in, but she was unfamiliar to her peers. No brown heroines in the fairytales she was exposed to left her with few role models. As an adult, a graduate in the medical world, she experienced a new kind of obstacle: being female in a male-driven hospital environment.

When she eventually walked across the stage to get her paediatric letters, with a drip in her arm, a pregnant belly, a toddler on her hip and heels that could shatter a glass ceiling, victory was bittersweet.






In the French region of Marennes-Oléron – where much of the technology of modern oysters farming was pioneered – oysters are still considered among the finest in the world. Like champagne, oysters from this region are protected by geographic distinction laws, with some even getting initials lasered into their shells, to preserve their prestige. *Portrait of an Oyster* travels across France, Europe, and North America, sampling some of the best oysters and restaurants in the world, including in the UK and Copenhagen, and then Boston, New York, New Orleans, and San Francisco.



HARDLY ANYONE EATS OYSTERS nowadays for the sole purpose of satiating their hunger. They only serve the purpose of nutrition to a limited degree. Consuming them constitutes a magical moment rather than creaturely necessity, a sensual experience rather than fulfillment of a basic need. In that sense, oysters now have more in common with art than with food. They represent enjoyment, or the premonition of it. "It's a one-on-one relationship," according to the greatest living expert on oysters, the American Rowan Jacobsen, who has tasted and described each of the over three hundred varieties found in North America. The oyster expert has pronounced dining on a dozen oysters to be one of the last remaining cultural rites of the animal sacrifice, a "Biomass Age atavism" still practiced today at the marble altars of the oyster "temples" in New Orleans, on the coasts





ALICE'S OXFORD

People and Places that Inspired Wonderland
 PETER HUNT

- This book is both a guide and a history, exploring the curious and entertaining glories of Oxford through two of the most famous fantasies in world literature

Alice's Adventures in Wonderland and *Through the Looking-Glass* are two of the most famous fantasies in world literature, and yet their roots are firmly in nineteenth century and the university city of Oxford, England.

Oxford's, streets, colleges and buildings, the River Thames, and the villages on its banks, are imbued with literally hundreds of intricate connections to the books. Their author, Charles Dodgson, aka Lewis Carroll, spent most of his life as an academic at Christ Church, one of the largest and oldest of the Oxford colleges. His muse, Alice Liddell, who is the thinly-disguised Alice of the books, was the daughter of the Dean of Christ Church, and she lived there as she was growing up. The 'Alice' books began as stories told to Alice and her sisters, and Dodgson incorporated local people, places, and events that they would recognise. But as the books grew, he included a much wider range of satire and caricature, until Oxford itself became an eccentric Wonderland.

This book, a guide and a history, explores the city, the colleges, and the river that Alice and Lewis Carroll knew and shared, in all their eccentric and entertaining glory.

Peter Hunt is Professor Emeritus in Children's Literature at Cardiff University and Adjunct Professor at Dublin City University.

And probably no city has absorbed an author and his characters and the origins of those characters into its cultural bloodstream more than Oxford.

In the mid-nineteenth century, a young mathematician, Charles Dodgson, studying at an Oxford college, Christ Church, transformed himself into a writer of fantasies under the pen name Lewis Carroll. In doing so, he transformed his muse, a real little girl, Alice Liddell—daughter of the dean of Christ Church—into a fantasy character, also called Alice, in what were to become two of the most famous books in the world: *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* and *Through the Looking-Glass and What Alice Found There*. Together, they have been called the 'great Oxford novel', even though there are more than 550 contenders for the title.

Charles Dodgson, Lewis Carroll, Alice Liddell and 'Alice': it is this four-headed creature which haunts the Oxford of today.

Alice Liddell's experience of Oxford began in June 1855 when she was three years old, when her family moved into the Christ Church deanery, and ended on 13 September 1880 when she went to Westminster Abbey in London to be married. Her fame, however, rests on a much shorter period of seven years, between Friday 25 April 1856 when she first met Dodgson, and Saturday 27 June 1863, when their friendship was suddenly suspended by her mother, probably because there were rumours that he was paying court to her sister, Lorina, who was fourteen. Their relationship never fully recovered, and as she grew up Alice and Dodgson only occasionally met, when she first Oxford, hardly spoke of him for sixty years.



10 ALICE'S OXFORD

Ashmolean Museum

Oxford's museums would have been visited regularly by Dodgson and Alice and her siblings, and many of the treasures would have formed part of their psyche. In their day, the Ashmolean, Britain's oldest public museum (which opened in 1683) was in Broad Street, on a site now occupied by the History of Science Museum. Its original collections date back to the seventeenth century, and three items particularly link the museum to the 'Alice' books.

The first in the collection of Anglo-Saxon artefacts which can be attributed to a fashion for Anglo-Saxon studies in the 1860s. It has been suggested that the phrase 'Anglo-Saxon attitudes' was coined by Dodgson to satirize the stylized positions of characters in Anglo-Saxon illustrations—such as the scene in *Looking-Glass*, with the White King and his messengers, Hama and Hagia.



'I've somebody with!' he exclaimed at last. 'But he's coming very slowly—and what curious attitudes he goes into!' (For the messenger kept slipping up and down, and wriggling like an eel, as he came along, with his great hands spread out like fins on each side.)

*'Not at all,' said the King. 'He's an Anglo-Saxon Messenger—and those are Anglo-Saxon attitudes. He only does them when he's happy. His name is Hagia.' (He pronounced it as an *is* before with 'supper'.)*
